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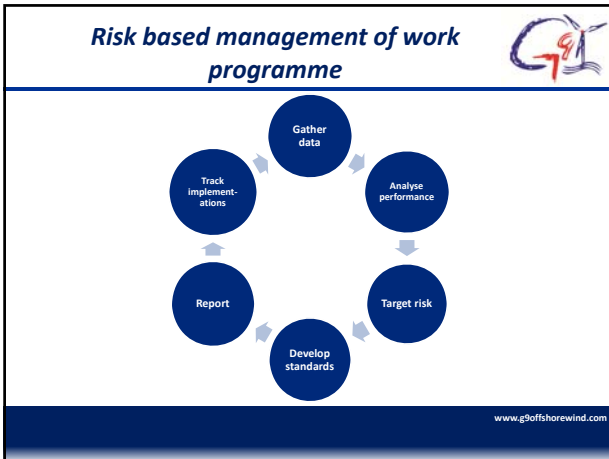
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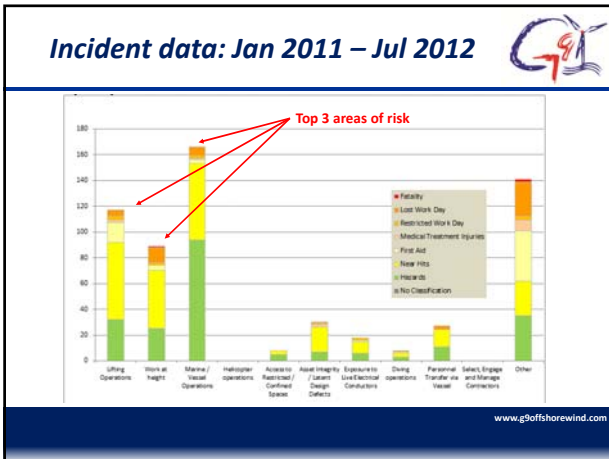
Incident data and analysis 

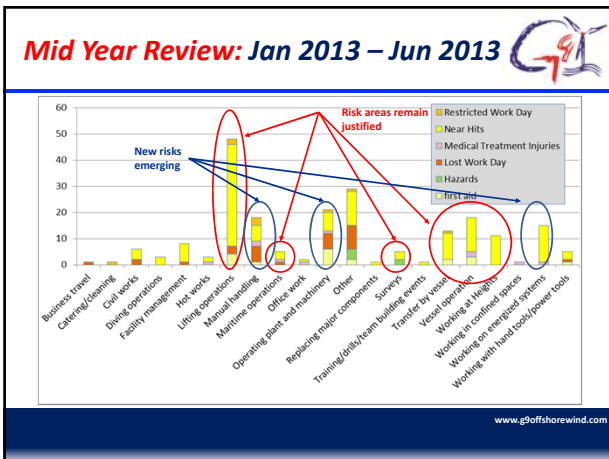
Purpose

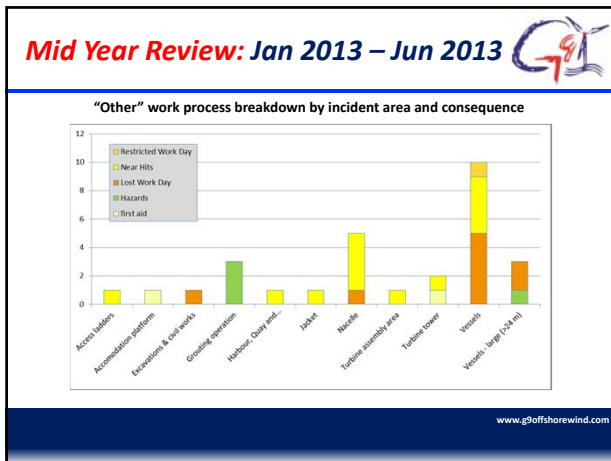
- To collect, analyse and share data and information on offshore wind HSE incidents
- To provide leadership through an evidence based work programme aimed at reducing the HSE risk
- Improve understanding and awareness of HSE issues as a basis for stakeholder engagement
- Enhance the safety performance of G9 members and their contractors

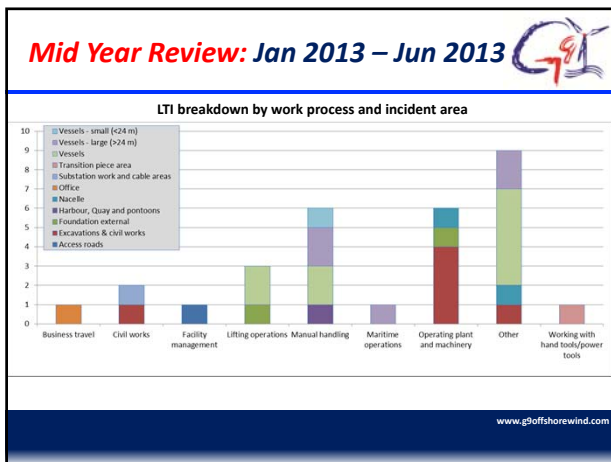
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Data analysis – going forward 

- Iterative process, incident template has already been revised once
- Focal Group will aim to capture frequency data for Q1 2014 onwards
- A 2013 incident data report will be made available on the G9 website


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Current workstreams

Justification


- Incident data showed 3 area of operations where there was a clear need to reduce the risk by enhancing requirements

Method

- To develop guidelines to improve safety performance in these operational areas

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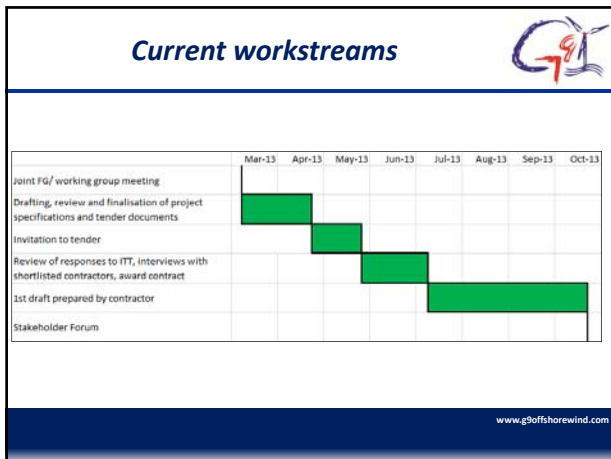



Current workstreams

Background

- Each workstream Leader is supported by a Working Group comprising specialists from G9 member companies – working groups formed in March
- Working groups have been involved in the development and review of project specifications and tender documents
- Contracts have been awarded for the three workstreams in late June/ early July

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- Current workstreams** 
- Working at Height
 - 1st draft to be provided to G9 by end of October
 - Lifting Operations
 - 1st draft provided to G9 mid-October
 - A x2 week internal G9 consultation (initiated 21st October) started
 - Marine Operations
 - 1st draft provided to G9
 - A x2 week internal G9 consultation (initiated 21st October) started
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- Current workstreams** 
- Each workstream deliverable to go through a consultation period with key stakeholders
 - Consultation period for x3 workstreams to begin in November
 - Opportunity to ask questions on x3 workstreams during sessions at the Stakeholder Forum
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Current workstreams 

- Consultation will be co-ordinated through the Energy Institute
- Revised drafts to be developed (based on consultation feedback) in Q1 2014
- Guidelines to be published by end Q1 2014
